

Understand the 2024 eCQM Requirements for the Medicare Promoting Interoperability Program

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CY 2024 Medicare Promoting Interoperability Program eCQM Requirements

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) would like to remind eligible hospitals and critical access hospitals (CAHs) participating in the Medicare Promoting Interoperability Program that they are required to report on a total of **six** electronic clinical quality measures (eCQMs) for the calendar year (CY) 2024 reporting period. This includes **three self-selected eCQMs, plus the Safe Use of Opioids – Concurrent Prescribing measure, Severe Obstetric Complications measure, and the Cesarean Birth measure.**

As a reminder, when participants report on the six required eCQMs, they must submit a full year's worth of data for the CY 2024 reporting period.

The below table showcases all eCQMs available to report on for CY 2024:

Short Name	Measure Name
Safe Use of Opioids	Safe Use of Opioids – Concurrent Prescribing
PC-02	Cesarean Birth
PC-07	Severe Obstetric Complications

STK-2	Discharged on Antithrombotic Therapy
STK-3	Anticoagulation Therapy for Atrial Fibrillation/Flutter
STK-5	Antithrombotic Therapy by End of Hospital Day Two
VTE-1	Venous Thromboembolism Prophylaxis
VTE-2	Intensive Care Unit Venous Thromboembolism Prophylaxis
HH-HYPO	Hospital Harm - Severe Hypoglycemia
HH-HYPER	Hospital Harm - Severe Hyperglycemia
HH-ORAE	Hospital Harm - Opioid-Related Adverse Events
GMCS	Global Malnutrition Composite Score
