

## Request for Information on the Scientific Registry of Transplant Recipients (SRTR)

HRSA seeks input from Industry and stakeholders to inform the development of formal Request for Proposal (RFP) for the Scientific Registry of Transplant Recipients (SRTR) to support ongoing evaluation of the scientific and clinical status of solid organ transplantation. The Request for Information (RFI) aims to:

- 1. Solicit feedback on ways to enhance components of the SRTR contract, including data synthesis, transparency of analysis, and analytical support to the OPTN, the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), and the United States Department of Health and Human Services (HHS).
- 2. Gauge interest in the upcoming RFP opportunity via statements of intent from prospective offerors.
- 3. Gain insight on ways to better utilize new and existing data sources and technology to optimize the SRTR and better meet patient and donor needs.
